

VALPLAST FLEXIBLE DENTURE CARE

Most patients become immediately accustomed to their comfortable and light-weight Valplast Flexible Denture. However, you may experience a brief adjustment period, especially if you have never worn a dental appliance before. Should you experience any persistent irritation, please consult our Dental Prosthetist so that he can make any necessary adjustments.

Valplast restorations, like your own teeth, require care and good oral hygiene.

To keep your Valplast restoration looking and feeling like new, please follow these simple directions:

- Loose particles can be removed with the use of a soft Denture Brush. It is essential that ordinary toothbrushes that have previously had toothpaste on them are not used on your denture as these will leave micro scratches on the surface of your appliance.
- If possible, rinse your Valplast Flexible Denture after eating to remove any food particles. Keep the partial in water or in denture cleaner whenever it is not being worn to keep the surface hydrated.
- Clean your Valplast Flexible Denture daily. The Val-Clean Concentrated Denture Cleaner will help effectively, quickly and safely maintain the cleanliness of Valplast partials as well as other removable dental appliances.
- Soak your Valplast Flexible Denture in Val-Clean as per product instructions for 10-15 minutes a day, some appliances may need overnight soaking to remove tough stains. This is very important as using Val-Clean maintains the warranty of the denture. After the one-month free supply is used please order the 12-month supply box from either Total Denture Care or online at www.ordervalplast.com.au
- Other cleaning can be achieved with the use of a sonic denture cleaner, or by placing the Valplast Flexible Denture under running water.
- Remember to brush your natural teeth and gums regularly as directed by your Dentist.

Additional Tips for the Care of your Valplast Flexible Denture:

- Cleanse the Valplast Flexible Denture daily and keep it in water whenever it is not being worn. Store brands of denture cleaner are not recommended for cleaning a Valplast dental appliance and will void warranty, as they may contain ingredients that can damage the Valplast or its colour.
- Toothpaste will scratch or dull the surface of your Valplast dental appliance and will void warranty if used. Be sure to remove your Valplast restoration whenever you brush your natural teeth.
- Please keep the appliance out of reach from pets. Dogs and other pets find dental appliances to be attractive chew toys.
- Valplast Flexible Dentures are very durable and are designed to give long term performance under normal usage. Please note that the Valplast base material will resist fracture or breakage better than the synthetic teeth that are embedded in it. Small accidents such as dropping the appliance in the sink or on the floor may not damage the Valplast, but may cause the teeth to fracture. Please handle the dental appliance with care.
